The desired certificate is as follows:-

1. No. of institutions already existing in the State : 52
2. No. of seats available or No. of doctors being produced annually: 6778 seats are available in medical colleges.
3. No. of doctors registered with the State Medical Council : 90965
4. No. of doctors in Government service: 12101 in PMHS and 1300 in Universities, Institutes & Medical Colleges.
5. No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas: **Related to Medical & Health Department.**
6. No. of doctors registered with Employment Exchange. No Registration in Employment Exchange. Doctor's registration are done in State Medical Faculty and Dental Faculty, U.P.
7. Doctor population ratio in the State: One Doctor on 2791 population
8. How the establishment of the college would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State: Majority of doctors who qualify is likely to stay in State.
9. The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State, be specified: Candidates must be domicile for state quota seats only.
10. Full justification for opening of the proposed college: to improve doctors population ratio.
11. Doctor-patient ratio proposed to be achieved: One Medical College of 100 intake capacity.

The Principal Autonomous State Medical College Society, **Jaunpur** applied for establishment of a medical college at **Jaunpur**. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Uttar Pradesh has decided to issue an essentiality certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical

College with 100 MBBS seats per year.

It is certified that:-

- (a) The applicant has undertaken a MOU with CMO to attach 330 bedded hospital for clinical teaching & training.
- (b) It is desirable to establish a medical college in the public interest;
- (c) Establishment of a Govt. Medical college at Jaunpur by Government of Uttar Pradesh is feasible.
- (d) Adequate clinical material as per the National Medical Commission norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the medical college as per MCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
